Dear resident,

Wigginton Heath Road Closures – Carriageway Investigation Work

I am writing to inform you that Oxfordshire County Council will be undertaking investigation work on a number of roads in the Wigginton area. This will include taking cores in the carriageway, digging trial pits to confirm locations of underground services and topographical surveys.

The locations and dates where we will be working are below – the attached plan shows more details.

- Main Road (to Milcombe) – 13th February to 16th February
- Un-named Road by the Waterfowl Sanctuary – 20th February to 21st February
- Un-named Road between Lodge Farm and Nill Farm – 22nd February to 23rd February
- Un-named Road, west of Wigginton Heath crossroads – 6th March to 7th March
- Un-named Road at Firs Garage – 20th March to 22nd March

The investigations are needed to help us design and plan resurfacing and edge strengthening work for later in the year.

Traffic Management

To enable these investigations to be carried out safely, the works will be carried out under a series of road closures and signed diversion routes will be put in place. It is hoped that these roads will be re-opened at the end of each shift but this will be subject to progress.

Staff (traffic gatemmen) will be positioned at either end of the closures to redirect traffic and pedestrians to ensure the safety of the public and workforce. We ask that you give them your full support whether you are a pedestrian, cyclist or motorist.

Every effort will be made to accommodate vehicular access to properties and businesses adjacent to the works and individual requirements should be agreed with the scheme

supervisor, Stuart Bowler, once works have started on site (contact details below).
