Write to the members of the Oxfordshire Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee (HOSC) to demand a) Horton downgrading plans are dealt with as a single public consultation and no decisions on permanent service removal must be taken separately and b) Horton downgrading plans must, as a single issue, be referred to the Secretary of State for Health who, in 2008 said centralisation of acute core services was wrong on the basis of the distance and that it would not result in a better service for the catchment.
